Enjoy a city of 3000 years of history where visitors fall in love with the weather, the magical streets, the tradition and the hospitable people.

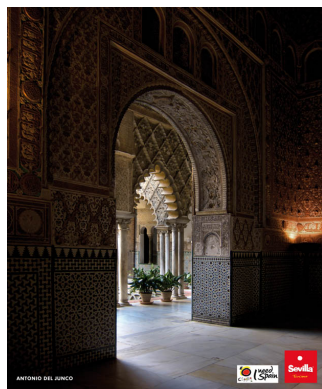

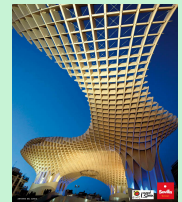


## Flamenco

## Gastronomy: A reflection of history

Sevilla's gastronomy reflects the entire history.

**“Gazpacho, croquetas, pescadito frito, vino, aceite, naranjas y almendras”**



As a result of the strong Arab, certain dishes such as gazpacho Andaluz is a delicious starter seen throughout the provinces of Andalucía and even the rest of Spain. Olives and croquetas are typical to enjoy with a beer or a glass of white wine.



Oranges are flavoring many dishes like the pork cochinito, salads, starters and desserts. The good weather, the long hours of light and the closeness to the sea marks the Sevilla cuisine. The typical dishes of Sevilla are Soldaditos de Pavia, Gazpacho, Pescaito Frito, Huevas Aliñas, Cola de Toro, Cazón de Adobo, Papas Aliñá, Bacalao con Tomate, Huevos a la Flamenca, Caracoles, Pincho Moruno, Pestiños and Yemas de San Leandro.

## PALACIO DE LAS DUEÑAS

Las Dueñas was built between the 15th and 16th centuries and the name was after a disappeared monastery of Santa Maria de la Dueñas, placed in an adjoining plot demolished in 1868. It belongs to Casa de Alba and in the XIX Century, Dueñas become a guesthouse having as an administrator Antonio Machado Sanchez father of the famous poet of Antonio Machado, who was born in Las Dueñas in 1875.

In the 20th Century Las Dueñas was the meeting point for the members of the European Royal Families and international personalities like Empress Eugenia de Montijo, King Alfonso XIII, Jacqueline Kennedy, Wallis Simpson and Grace Kelly with Rainer of Monaco.
